

EXCEPTION: A concealed handgun, licensed pursuant to the Concealed Handgun Carry Act, is permitted on the premises of restaurants serving beer and wine only (subject to owner/manager consent) and retail establishments that serve or sell alcoholic beverages for off premise consumption. This does NOT apply to bars and restaurants that serve beer, wine and spirits.
